

Shoghi Effendi

Shoghi Effendi (1897-1957), grandson of 'Abdu'l-Bahá, was born in Akka, studied in Haifa and Beirut, and attended Balliol College, Oxford, in 1920, until his studies were interrupted by the passing of 'Abdu'l-Bahá. He was the Guardian of the Bahá'i Faith for 36 years from 1921 to 1957, when he passed away unexpectedly in London.

The Guardianship

In His Will and Testament 'Abdu'l-Bahá conferred the mantle of Guardian of the Cause and infallible Interpreter of its teachings upon His eldest grandson, Shoghi Effendi, and confirmed the authority and guarantee of divine guidance decreed by Bahá'u'lláh for the Universal House of Justice on all matters "which have not outwardly been revealed in the Book."

The Guardianship

The Guardianship and the Universal House of Justice can thus be seen to be, in the words of Shoghi Effendi, the "Twin Successors" of Bahá'u'lláh and 'Abdu'l-Bahá. They are the supreme institutions of the Administrative Order which was founded and anticipated in the Kitáb-i-Aqdas and elaborated by 'Abdu'l-Bahá in His Will.

Spiritual Assemblies and The Divine Plan

During the thirty-six years of his ministry, Shoghi Effendi raised up the structure of elected Spiritual Assemblies—the Houses of Justice referred to in the Kitáb-i-Aqdas, now in their embryonic stage and with their collaboration initiated the systematic implementation of the Divine Plan that 'Abdu'l-Bahá had laid out for the diffusion of the Faith throughout the world.
